



ADVANCED COURSE

On enrolment in the IRMTNZ Advanced Course, Course Participants are COMMITTED TO THREE PHASES OF STUDY AND A PRACTICAL WORKSHOP DAY.

Course Participants will be expected to show evidence of networking through the various opportunities made available.

The Advanced course should be completed within 6 months of registration.

All tasks must be completed satisfactorily to complete the Course.

PHASE ONE 'WE'RE IN THIS TOGETHER'

networking, business practice, professional development, resource development

PHASE TWO 'PEDAGOGY MATTERS'

- A) **COMPULSORY TASKS:** the teaching of: theory, sight reading, aural training, musicianship, practical analysis, repertoire, style and interpretation, advanced technique,
- B) **OPTIONS (SELECT 3):** detailed studies of -baroque, classical, romantic, or 20th century, memorising and performance techniques, sitting practical diplomas

PHASE THREE "IT'S YOUR TURN" AT A CONTACT WORKSHOP

Such topics as a personal performance and practical teaching demo to peers, (involving analysis, history, theory, aural, KCs, application) skills of teaching will be demonstrated, discussed and experienced. The workshop will be designed to best cater for the needs and interests of the Course Participants at the time. It will take a full day, and will ideally also involve some networking and social time with local IRMT teachers and Course Participants of other levels.
